Job description:

We are seeking Camp Counsellors to lead and organize groups of children, supporting teams in programming activities, and ensuring children's safety and well-being. The ideal candidates will work with other partners to lead groups of children in monitoring mealtimes, guiding children and youth during games and activities, and leading groups to scheduled events.

Bring your unique talents, genuine heart, endless enthusiasm, and best self to this incredible camp for children and youths.

Qualifications for a summer camp counsellor:

- A high school graduate or an equivalent and above 18 years of age.
- Having a Passion for outdoor adventure and mentoring children and youths.
- Two to three years experience as a camp counselor or experience in coordinating children's programming.

Responsibilities:

- Stay and participate with assigned campers during daily activities such as swimming, sports, evening activities and Special Interest Programs.
- Maintain the health and safety of all campers/ Supervise the health, safety, and personal belongings of assigned campers.
- Work closely with a co-counsellor to identify and meet camper needs.
- Create group unity and provide opportunities for each camper to experience success.
- Oversee and assist campers with their daily hygiene routines as needed.
- Help each camper meet the camp goals, including increased self-esteem.
- Provide guidance and encouragement for camper participation in activities.
- Communicate openly with camp Leadership Staff about participant experiences and concerns
- Adhere to all of camp's policies and regulations.
- Be a positive role model who sets a good example for campers and peers (exemplary character, good judgment, approachable, etc.).
- Should be flexible and Willing to stay at Moorelands Camp, Dorset for the duration of the Camp and share Cabin with campers.

Requirements:

- Two to three years previous camp experience, childcare or working with children in a supervised group setting.
- Ability to participate in physical activities alongside campers, such as running, jumping, swimming, and more.
- Ability to deal with highly stressful (physically and emotionally) situations with composure.
- Excellent interpersonal and team building skills.
- Good verbal communication and conflict resolution skills.
- Must be willing to accept supervision, guidance, and constructive feedback.
- Ability to communicate in French or any other language is an asset.
- Must be flexible and willing to stay at Moorelands Camp, Dorset for the duration of the Camp and share Cabin and bathrooms with campers.
- ECE diploma or an equivalent is an added asset.

Additional Information:

- This is a 1-week contract from August 17-22, 2025, and we will provide an honorarium of \$500.
- Vulnerable Sector Screening is mandatory. Teresa Group will reimburse you for the costs.
- Mandatory 5 weeks of trainings (I Day of training per week- 2 in person and 3 virtual) will occur before the camp. Counsellors will receive honoraria, transport, and meals for the training sessions. There will be an exception of those living far outside of Toronto
- Must possess Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification (or willing to obtain prior to starting the role).
- Work hours maybe irregular with a schedule that stretches between 7am-8pm or attend to emergencies beyond work hours.

We welcome applications from diverse candidates, and we do recognise the strength that lies in uniqueness. Youth living with or affected by HIV and ECE students are highly encouraged to apply. Those who require accommodation can make their needs known when contacted for an interview. Teresa Group will provide means of transport to and from the camp, lodging and meals.
